Invites Admission Of Students to (BEd) Literacy Studies Degree Programme (Part-time)

- Applications are invited for admission to the B.Ed. Literacy Studies Degree Programme -offered by The University of the West Indies, Mona Campus in collaboration with Bethlehem Moravian College commencing August 2009. The programme should normally be completed over five semesters and two summers. Instructional delivery includes face-to-face and distance modalities. Most courses will be offered at Bethlehem Moravian College.

MATRICULATION REQUIREMENTS

Applicants should possess:

- a three-year trained Teachers' Diploma in either Literacy Studies, or Primary Education or equivalent.
- other candidates may be considered subject to professional assessment.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY TEST (ELPT)

- Candidates who do not have a Grade I in CSEC CXC English A or Grade A in GCE O'Level English Language or Grade I or II in CAPE Communication Studies or an approved equivalent will be required to sit and pass the English Language Proficiency Test set by the UWI. The cost of the test is \$2000 which must be paid at any branch of NCB.
- The Test dates are June 19, 2009, and August 7, 2009
